### Report Cards

Student report cards will be distributed at Parent Teacher Conferences. Please remember that our report cards are standards—based. Standards—based



report cards list the most important skills that students should learn in each subject and help our teachers provide specific feedback about these skills through the use of a key (M, P, N). Although student report cards contain some helpful feedback about your child's current developmental level, there are also some things to remember about these reports:

- Many standards are "end-of-year targets." Students should not be meeting this expectation until much later in the year and a mark of "Progressing" is expected.
- Some standards get increasingly more complex throughout the year and marks may only reflect what the class has covered at this point. If you see an "NA" listed on the report, classrooms are still working their way towards that skill.
- As expectations increase each marking period, it is possible that marks will change throughout the year. Students all progress at different rates and may start to struggle/do much better as the year goes on.

Standards-based report cards can help provide more consistency across each grade level because all students are evaluated on the same skills, regardless of classroom. Parents can see exactly which skills and knowledge their child has acquired, and which areas they may still need some additional help with!

### Winter Doldrums

As the weather starts to get colder and the snow begins to fly, many of our students begin to spend more time indoors, with fewer opportunities to be active. If your child is reluctant to get outside and play in the snow, consider the following ideas for them to get their energy out:



- Indoor obstacle course: Pillow-piles make great hurdles and washcloths are terrific for stepping stones!
- Performances: Have your child act out a scene from their favorite book or movie, or lip-sing their favorite playlist.
- Learn a dance routine together: There are plenty of great options available on YouTube!
- Exercise videos: Get in shape together and find a family-friendly exercise tutorial.
- Build a fort: Blankets, sheets, and old boxes can all be great tools for making castles and tunnels!




