One of our most exciting traditions at Alden Primary School is our annual Halloween Parade! Students enjoy dressing up in their costumes and seeing the creativity of their classmates!

In order for our parade to continue to be successful, we are asking that all of our families assist us with several things. Please review the bullet points below for additional information.

- Due to safety concerns and lack of space, visitors are not permitted to attend our parade.
- Our parade will be held indoors in the Primary School hallways. The weather is difficult to predict, and we do not want students to have to cover their costumes up with coats/sweatshirts.
- Our parade usually takes place in the afternoon and communication to the classrooms will be difficult at this time. Please do not plan for any early dismissals between 1:00-2:00 PM on October $27^{\text {th }}$. If this is unavoidable, please contact the Main Office ASAP.
- Students should be able to handle putting the majority of their costume on themselves. Teachers and staff can assist with difficult tasks like zippering and buttoning, but they will not be able to apply things like make-up and hair dye.


## General Parade Reminders

* Students should not wear their costumes to school.
* Fake weapons are not permitted.
* Be considerate of others: no fake blood or excessive gore that could frighten young classmates.
- Because we want our families to be able to share in the excitement of this day, we are planning to record our parade and share the footage through our website. We will do our best to get the video uploaded as quickly as we can! Students on our "Do Not Photograph List" will not be visible in the video.
