



8th Grade Math What You Need to Know

We will be using **Microsoft Teams** and **One Note** as our online learning platforms.

- Check for feedback from teachers

What about grades?

Your grade will be based on total points earned. You will earn points in weekly sheets, graded class assignments, and assessments.

Weekly Sheets will alternate between multiple choice questions one week to open response questions the following week. All weekly sheets are mixed review, meaning that questions will be from a variety of topics.


- Weekly sheets may be found in your One Note Notebook. Paper copies will be available upon request.
- Each will be worth 10 points (5 for accuracy; 5 for completion). If no work is shown, the maximum grade you may earn is 5 out of 10. Show work!
- You will have an opportunity during class to ask questions throughout the week.
- You may correct errors *only until the due date.*
- You may submit late work with no penalty. However, you will *not be able to correct errors on late sheets*.

Classwork:

- Some assignments will be graded; some will not be graded. You will know before you begin if the assignment is graded.
- Independent practice assignments will be completed during class time, so that you have a chance to ask questions and get feedback as you work.

Assessments will be administered for each topic of learning.


- The number of points depends on the assessment.
- Assessments might be like a quiz or a test that is administered on a single day, possibly using technology.
- Assessments might be a problem that students will work on over the course of several days (Performance Tasks).
- Topics may have a Check for Understanding AND a Performance Task.




Materials needed for class daily:
