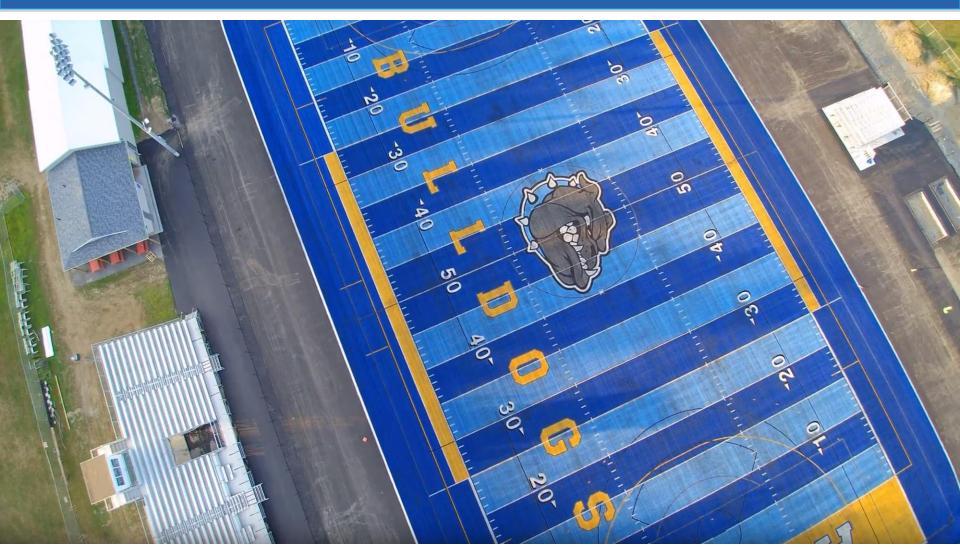

History of Events:

- Vision 20/20 was approved by the voters in December of 2017
- The design team met with staff and coaches to design a facility which would be a 50 year investment into the athletic and academic programs of the District
- The pool renovations were approved by the State Education Department in February of 2019





History of Events:

- Contractor bids were received on April 5, 2019
- Bid results came in over the allocated budget
- Results were presented to the Community Based Committee (CBC) and the Board of Education on April 16th
- The CBC tasked the design and construction team to advise on a course of action as well as how much money would be needed to move forward with the project







- 8-lane pool with new starting blocks
- Multiple diving boards with regulation depth diving pit and additional building height to meet new athletic standards
- Accessible ramp for easy access for swimmers of all ages and abilities
- Seating for 500 spectators, with operable bleachers for maximum flexibility





Vision 20/20 – Aquatic Center Building the Future

- New public bathrooms in aquatics center and a dedicated entrance for swimming and pool events
- New scoreboard and competition timing system
- New pumps, drainage, and pool heating systems with cutting-edge salt water filtration system
- Renovated locker rooms and shower facilities, separating the gym locker rooms from the pool locker room facilities

Phase 1 Bid Savings	(\$534,823)
PROPOSITION	\$5,775,777





Phase 2 – Budget Considerations:

- Use of the existing additional capital reserve fund and NYS Building Aid will offset the additional construction costs
- There will be <u>NO ADDITIONAL TAX IMPACT</u> if this proposition is approved
